III Crew for the Telecommunications Section

1. The qualification, requirements and ranking system for radiotelephone operator have remained as previously recognized
2. A radio operator may acquire certificates of ordinary operator or radiotelephone operator by taking training courses or passing exams with the approval from competent authority of the central government.

IV For the re-certification of new Practicing Certificate of Officer of Fishing Vessel, applicants shall submit the following to the competent authority at the central government:

1. A completed application form and 2 photos in 2-inch size, taken within the recent one year that should be revealing shoulders and clear facial without wearing hat.
2. A photocopy of the Fishing Vessel Crew Handbook held by the applicant.
3. The original copy of the practicing certificate withheld.
4. Reference for experiences in engaging fisher operation for long as 1 year period any time within the past 5 years, or 3 months of such an experience gained in the past 1 year.
5. Other relevant documentation.
