III Crew for the Telecommunications Section

- 1. The qualification, requirements and ranking system for radiotelephone operator have remained as previously recognized
- 2. A radio operator may acquire certificates of ordinary operator or radiotelephone operator by taking training courses or passing exams with the approval from competent authority of the central government.
- IV For the re-certification of new Practicing Certificate of Officer of Fishing Vessel, applicants shall submit the following to the competent authority at the central government:

- 1. A completed application form and 2 photos in 2-inch size, taken within the recent one year that should be revealing shoulders and clear facial without wearing hat.
- 2. A photocopy of the Fishing Vessel Crew Handbook held by the applicant.
- 3. The original copy of the practicing certificate withheld.
- 4. Reference for experiences in engaging fisher operation for long as 1 year period any time within the past 5 years, or 3 months of such an experience gained in the past 1 year.
- 5. Other relevant documentation.
